Activities & Amenities

With more than three miles of shoreline. PD offers plenty of room for relaxation and fun. There are numerous beach accesses, including the Dunes House and the Disney Beach House parking areas. Try a round of tennis or pickleball, or play golf on one of our three championship courses. Lessons, clinics, fittings, and tournaments are available. Rent bicycles or kayaks from Hilton Head Outfitters, or pick up any items you may have forgotten at the General Store. There are also a number of restaurants right here in PD. LEAMINGTON

Bluffton, Savannah,

We are so fortunate to have Loggerhead Sea Turtles nesting right here on the beaches of Hilton Head Island! How can you help keep them safe?

Flatten sandcastles and fill in holes dug on the beach. Leave nothing except footprints between sunset and sunrise so our turtles don't become injured or trapped.

Turn off all beachside lighting at night and only use LED flashlights with red bulbs for night beach walking. (White lights are harmful to our nesting mother turtles and hatchlings.) **The Town of Hilton Head Island requires that lights on structures visible from the beach be turned off after 10 p.m. from May 1 to October 31. Windows must be covered by draperies or shades.**
